

AN UPDATE FROM YOUR COMMONAGE ROAD IMPROVEMENT COMMITTEE (CRIC)

Dear Neighbour,

The following is an update on road improvements that are scheduled to take place in late October between Predator Ridge and the Commonage and Bailey Road junction.



The Commonage Road Improvement Committee (CRIC) in conjunction with the Regional District of North Okanagan (RDNO) has been working together to improve the safety of the road for motorists and cyclists, between Predator Ridge and the junction of Commonage and Bailey Roads.

In early September we were successful in bringing RDNO, the City of Vernon (CoV) and the Ministry of Transportation and Infrastructure (MoTI) into a partnership to pave the shoulders of the road from 0.5 of a meter up to 1.0 meter where possible.

We also met with MoTI to discuss the installation of the remaining delineators/reflectors on some of the more dangerous corners between Predator Ridge and the Compost Facility. The work is scheduled to take place next week, between October 26th and 29th (weather dependant). If the weather does not cooperate the project will be moved to March 2021.

Road maintenance for Commonage Road (from the Vernon City Limits up to Predator Ridge) and Bailey Road remains under contract with ACCIONA. Last year we experienced a very concerning start to our winter road maintenance. MoTI has assured us that all issues have been addressed and corrected with ACCIONA. Our road is classified as a CLASS B road, which means it falls into the second highest winter road maintenance category in the the province.
