WHY A SIREN

The Emergency Evacuation Siren is needed **BECAUSE** we live in a community that butts against dense forest areas. Our community is spread out to retain some of its natural beauty and land area, but that makes evacuation more complex and dangerously time-consuming. Hence, the siren fulfils a strategy that provides for timely notification of an evacuation situation, which lessens this complexity and contributes to a more safe and efficient evacuation should this be necessary.

The siren project is community driven, by your **PRCEMC**. 27% of the cost will come from Predator Ridge Ltd. Partnership based on staff, guests, and development latecomers. Sparkling Hill Resort will contribute 20% of the cost, based on staff numbers and resort guests. The remaining 53% is contributed by the existing 750 occupied residential homes across Predator Ridge to date. Therefore Predator Ridge is contributing to help the safety of their community, but they will recover part of their investment from future homeowners. This is the same whether Predator contributes to an emergency siren or builds a new dog park. In reality, Predator is a business that has to recover what they spend, and costs are recovered to some degree at least, from future development.

HOW CAN YOU HELP

The siren will support the City's emergency notification efforts, in particular by audibly notifying those who are in a remote outdoor location, or are indoors and not near other forms of notification or wireless alerts when an evacuation is ordered. Your investment of \$75 - \$100 towards this project will assist in the safety of our community and Residents.

We recognize that not everyone's financial situation is the same, so we ask that you please support this fundraising initiative as best as possible. If your circumstances allow for additional funds, we will welcome the support. At the end of the day, we are all building a better, safer community together.
